



7. Health and Safety Policy

Students and staff shall have a safe and physical and emotional learning environment. Therefore, the principal must:

- 1. Take all reasonable steps to protect students, staff and visitors to the school from unsafe or unhealthy conditions or practices
- 2. Ensure that the staff code of conduct is implemented effectively
- 3. Ensure there is zero tolerance to bullying and there are effective processes in place
- 4. Comply with the provisions of the Health & Safety at Work Act 2015
- 5. Provide a smoke free environment
- 6. Ensure a risk analysis management system (RAF) is carried out where and when appropriate
- Seek approval for all overnight stay/camps attesting first to their compliance to (4) above
- 8. Consult with the community every two years regarding the health programme being delivered to students
- 9. Advise the Presiding Member of any emergency situations as soon as possible
