

18.2 Student Disciplinary Committee Terms of Reference

Purpose:

To ensure that processes relating to the suspension of students adhere to the requirement of the Education and Training Act 2020and Ministry of Education guidelines.

Committee Members:

Include all members of the Board excluding the Principal. The chair of the committee is the Presiding Member or in the chairs absence, will be determined by the committee. The quorum for the committee shall be three members.

Delegated Authority:

That the powers conferred on the Board under Sections 81 of The Education and Training Act 2020 be delegated to the disciplinary committee of the Board of trustees. The committee will:

- Act in fairness, without bias or prejudice and with confidentially
- Act within the legislation and the MOE guidelines
- Act only on written and agreed information, not verbal hearsay
- Use processes of natural justice in discipline hearing procedures
- Make recommendations on discipline matters to the Board as necessary

The Board will be kept informed of the number of stand-downs, suspensions, exclusions and expulsions at each Board meeting by the Principal.
